Certificate Course on Environment and Sustainable Development Communication

Background

Centre for Environment Education (CEE) was established in 1984 as a Centre of Excellence in Environment Education of the Ministry of Environment, Forest and Climate Change (MoEF&CC), Government of India.

Communication for Sustainable Development (CSD), a core unit of CEE, edits and publishes research on Education for Sustainable Development, provides specialised communication and training for sustainable development, develops public awareness programs on policy and practice relating to Sustainable Development Goal areas. CSD also manages a range of projects on a consultancy basis that involve

- (i) Editorial services,
- (ii) Preparation of case studies
- (iii) Global sustainability and citizenship education programs
- (iv) Media projects, films and materials on ESD

As part of the specialized communication training provided by CSD, the following short term intensive program is available.

Module 1

Communication

This module provides an orientation to various definitions and theories, with special emphasis on print and other media, and teaches essential skills, different styles and practical guidelines for the improvement of one's writing skills.

- Basics of writing
- Style issues and plagiarism
- Mass communication
- Journalism
- New Media – Audio visual, web and social media
- Writing on the environment

Module 2

Water Resources

This module covers various water based ecosystems such as marine and wetlands. It also focuses on water quality, its pollution, factors leading to water scarcity across the world and ways to overcome this crisis.

- Global water problems
- Drinking water & sanitation

Module 3

Biodiversity & Protected Areas

The module covers biodiversity in sanctuaries, national parks and their importance. It also stresses on the various ecosystems, including fragile ecosystems, found on earth and their uses, wild life trade and conservation.

Module 4

Climate Change

This module covers science of climate change, climate policy at national level and international dialogues. It also focuses on climate actions—adaptation and mitigation strategies at individual as well as collective level.

- Mitigation
- Climate Change Policy

Methodology

- Study material in the three subjects sent to participants in a phased manner, chapter wise
- Assignment at the end of each chapter – participant has to complete this by identifying a local issue and developing a communication product on it
- Evaluation and detailed feedback provided to participant on each assignment
- Online discussion forum for clarifying questions, discussing issues and generally seeking help from Course Counsellors
- Direct interaction on Skype at specified times
