

Bio Medical Waste Treatment Plant Manager: Technical and Operations (based in Kalaburagi, Karnataka)

About CHAMP:

CHAMP is a common biomedical waste treatment facility designed, set up and operated by CEE. The site is situated 15 km from the main city of Kalaburagi and is providing services to all HCEs of Kalaburagi city and talukas.

Job Description and Requirements

The Manager of Bio-Medical Waste Treatment Plant (CHAMP) is responsible to oversee the overall daily operations within the waste treatment facility site.

The role of Manager includes:

1. Work force supervision and ensuring required manpower at the plant in all shifts
2. enforcing plant procedures and policies,
3. conducting daily monitoring and reviews, and overseeing training programs
4. to ensure that the plant and its operators comply with Biomedical Waste Management Rules, 2016 standards by regularly testing and keeping meticulous records.
5. be responsible for maintaining a safe work environment and ensuring all equipment is in proper working condition.
6. Do liaisoning with state and district officials on issues related with technical details of the plant and its performance.
7. The Manager is expected to conduct timely sensitization sessions and trainings for healthcare personnel or officials regarding plant's functioning, current rules and the expectations from the hospitals on segregation practices for effective functioning of the plant.
8. Effective and timely supervision on the collection system and tracking system for effective waste management and monitoring is also expected by the manager.
9. Ensure regular collection of pending dues through follow up and staff deputation as required.
10. The manager will prepare information, education and communication material and appropriate promotional materials with the aim to meet waste reduction and recycling targets.

Work Environment

The waste treatment plant manager job is physically demanding and involves 24X7 involvement, mostly working with clients (outdoor duties) and on site of medical waste treatment every day and in all types of weather. Since medical waste management comes under Essential Service and Maintenance Activity, hence plant manager would need to attend to the requirements of the plant operations and trouble shooting even during late evenings, weekends and holidays.

The duties would be for 6 days a week, timings from 9am to 6pm.

Educational Requirements

UG: B.Tech/B.E or equivalent, in Biomedical, Environmental, Chemical, Mechanical or related field

PG preferred M.Tech/ME in Chemical, Environmental, Mechanical engineering

Experience Requirements

- Proven minimum of 3 years relevant work experience in plant /site supervision
- Proven managerial experience of handling a team, operations and maintenance activities

- Familiarity with industry standard policy, legal requirement, equipment and technical expertise
- Knowledge of safety, quality, productivity, demand creation, inventory and documentation processes
- Efficient working on Computers and IT skills: MIS, documentation and reporting and training presentations
- Ability to create accountability and to lead by example
- Strong team building, decision-making and people management skills
